*A team's total points were determined by adding the following points:*

- 1) *Multiplying a team's winning % by 10.*
- 2) *Multiplying a team's losing % by -10.*
- 3) *25 points for a two-loss or a one loss/one tie season.*
- 4) *50 points for a one-loss or no-loss/one-tie season.*
- 5) *100 points for a Championship Season (AP or Coaches Polls).*
- 6) *Minus 25 points for a losing season, minus 50 for no win season.*
- 7) *Finally, a team's points were normalized to Nebraska's total points.*
